

**RAVINIA BUSINESS DISTRICT MARKET STUDY REPORT  
PRESENTATION FEBRUARY 11**

The Community and Land Use Economics (CLUE) Group will present the findings of their 2009 Ravinia Business District Market Study at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2010, in the Millennium Room at the Ravinia School, 763 Dean Avenue.

In advance of the City Council's consideration to accept the consultant's report, a "Playbook" meeting is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. on Friday, February 12, 2010, at which time the consultants will facilitate a workshop to guide the Ravinia Business District Leadership Group, which was appointed by Mayor Belsky and is comprised of key Ravinia Business District stakeholders, through the process of implementing their recommendations. Also joining this group as a consultant and an ex-officio member is real estate broker Steve Schwartz of Baum Realty.
